Job Summary:

Under the direct supervision of the Manager Medical Imaging Services, the incumbent will be responsible for performing general diagnostic procedures in accordance with the organization's policies and procedures whilst maintaining international standards.

Qualifications and Experience:

- First degree in Diagnostic Imaging or equivalent from a recognized University.
- Registration by the Council of Professions Supplementary to medicine.
- At least one (1) year experience.

Key responsibilities will include:
