Job Summary:

Under the direction of the Artisan 4, performs repairs to plumbing and lighting fixtures at health centres. Provides medical oxygen at clinics for patients. Records the daily usage of energy at the hospital. Monitors the use of steams, medical gas, water, and sewer. Provides assistance to the Artisan 4 on a daily basis.

Qualification and Experience:

HEART Level II in a related technical field such as Plumbing, Electrical Installation or Welding

At least two (2) years working experience in the field of general maintenance.

A DEFINITE ASSET

Two (2) subjects at the GCE "O" Level or CXC Level to include Mathematics, English Language or a Technical/Science subject.

Key Responsibilities:

- Carries out work outlined in work orders, records daily energy consumption such as water usage, electricity usage and cooking gas usage.
- Assembles furniture and equipment.
- Performs minor masonry work in the Health Facilities.
- Checks the domestic water supply to ensure that all the required levels are maintained.
- Conducts minor plumbing work eg replacing face basins and toilets and assist with major plumbing when needed.
- Conducts minor carpentry work as requested by the Supervisor.
- Performs daily checks on generators to ensure unit is fully functional.
- Any other duties assigned by the Artisan 4.

Special Conditions Associated with The Job

As a condition of employment, the incumbent will be required to:

- Possess the willingness and ability to work scheduled weekends, holidays, and shifts
- Work on an unscheduled basis
- Work in the event of an emergency

Physical and Sensory Requirements

- Ability to stand, sit, bend, stoop as necessary to supervise and perform maintenance and repairs

- Possess manual dexterity and finger coordination to grasp, hold, turn or squeeze objects, tools and equipment
- Possess a sense of touch necessary to distinguish texture, and temperature during the performance of maintenance and repairs duties
- Possess a sense of vision and hearing at a necessary level to diagnose problems, use tools, and implement preventative or corrective solutions
